## **Transportation Finds Motivation with New Cameras**



Our drivers care about the safety of their passengers, which is why all buses at UDS are equipped with Motive cameras. Motive cameras help monitor the behavior of each driver, providing a base score that deducts points based on speeding, hard braking, hard accelerating, hard cornering and speeding.

Since implementing the cameras, hard acceleration has decreased by 77%, hard braking is down 81%, speeding by 60% and hard cornering has decreased by 94%. In the future, the goal is to also decrease the idle time of the entire fleet to help reduce fuel consumption and costs.

To further motivate our drivers, the Transportation department runs a monthly contest where the winner with the best score receives a \$25 gift card. **Cathy Turner** (pictured above) is our winner for April and May. Past winners include **Tony Elton** for February and **Barb Bryant** won the top prize in March. Thank you for keeping our passengers safe!


